- a. Entry Form:
- i. All Competitors must use this link: <https://www.sporty.co.nz/viewform/385498> complete the Entry Form for their Category. Event Organisers reserve the right to refuse any Entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code. Entry Fee refunds policy will be at the discretion of the Category Coordinators/Administrator.
- ii. In completing the Entry Form, Competitors (Drivers and Entrants) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport New Zealand National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules.
- b. Opening and Closing Dates:
Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close (at normal fees) on 29 October 2025 at 1700hrs via the MotorSport New Zealand App: <https://www.sporty.co.nz/viewform/385498>. A Late Entry Fee will apply to entries received after this date.
- Entry Fees:
The Entry Fee for this Event is as agreed between the relevant Category Coordinator and the Promoter and is payable to the Category Coordinator/Administrator.
- c. Pit Marquees:
Pit Marquees along with power are available at an extra cost, please refer to your Category Coordinator/Administrator for more details.

6. **COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS & UNDERSTANDING:**

- a. Licence Requirements:
Unless otherwise stated in the individual Championship or Accredited Series Articles, each Driver must hold as a minimum a MotorSport New Zealand National C1 Grade Competition Licence or:
- Hold a Motorsport Australia National Competition Licence and valid Trans-Tasman Visa for the Event; or
 - Hold the minimum of the highest Grade National Licence issued by a Foreign ASN required for the Event and has obtained approval to compete from the ASN that issued their Licence.
- b. Entrants: (GT World Challenge & GT4 Australia under Motorsport Australia Regulations)
If the Entrant is other than a Driver, a MotorSport New Zealand Entrants Licence in the name of the Entrant is required. This is separate to a MotorSport New Zealand Competition Licence.
- c. New Drivers:
Any Driver(s) who are racing at one of their first three(3) race events or who have not previously competed at the circuit must indicate to their Category Coordinator/Administrator or The Secretary of the Event and attend the New Competitors Briefing session. The time and place for this briefing will be detailed in Supplementary Regulations Part Two.
- d. Drivers Briefing:
A written Drivers Briefing will be emailed to all Competitors prior to the Event.
Compulsory Drivers Briefing's will be held on Friday 31st October and Saturday 1st November at times and locations as specified in the Supplementary Regulations Part Two.

A Compulsory Drivers Briefing for **GTWC Australia pwd by AWS** will be held in the Podium Suite above the Pit Lane Garages on **Friday 31st October at 09:00**.

7. **DOCUMENTATION & SAFETY AUDIT INSPECTION:**

(GT World Challenge Australia pwd by AWS & Monochrome GT4 Australia under separate arrangement)

- a. Documentation:
Documentation will take place in the Race Administration Office behind the Pit Lane Garages all Competitors must complete Documentation prior to Qualifying.
- NB:** for Competitors taking part in the Friday Practice Sessions Documentation must be completed prior to entering the Circuit for Practice. Competitors are reminded that they need to bring their current Competition Licence, MotorSport New Zealand Member Club Membership Card and Vehicle Log Book to the Event, at the completion of documentation, competitors will be issued with a "passed sticker", which **MUST** be attached to the rear quarter window before entering the circuit.

b. Scrutineering Audit Inspection:

The listed Series Scrutineers will arrange in conjunction with the Chief Scrutineer of the event all management of their Class's Logbooks and carry out Safety Audits as required. All other class Safety Audits will be controlled by the Chief Scrutineer from 07:30 Friday of the Event, prior to each Competition Vehicles' first Qualifying Session.

No Transporters or Teams are permitted to enter the Venue until the above times. The Paddock Area is for Race Cars Only. There will be a Paddock Manager in each location who will advise you of your Pit Location and Transporter/Trailer designated parking area. Please also refer to the Paddock Plan prior to arriving at the venue.

Each Competitor will receive from their Category Coordinator/Administrator a "Parking" sticker to allow you entry to the restricted Competitor Car Park via Gate Two. No sticker No entry. All other parking is in main public car park, enter via Gate One behind the Apartments.

b. The following are requirements of the venue and Event Organisers:

- No passenger vehicles or trucks are allowed in the Paddock area after 09:30hrs Saturday 1st November.
- There will be times during the event when the Paddock Area is **CLOSED** for any vehicle access other than race cars. This will be done to eliminate traffic congestion when Race Cars are returning to their Pit Area, Please respect the marshals decision to close the paddock at this time.

c. All access lanes in and around the pits must be kept clear at all times during the event.

d. When unloading your vehicle from your race transporter or trailer, please ensure this is done promptly to avoid congestion.

e. Competitors must work on their race vehicles in their allocated Pit Paddock Area.

- f. Competitors **may commence pack down** from their allocated Support Paddock position on Sunday 2nd November after their final Race, at the discretion of the Paddock Manager and all due consideration must be given to other Categories still Competing. Pack Down for the loading of cars back into containers for GT World Challenge & GT4 Australia will commence after their final Races on Sunday.

9. PADDOCK AREA MOVEMENTS:

- a. Transporting equipment i.e. tyres, jacks and tools to and from the Pit Lane during Category Sessions must be achieved by the Crew carrying them or the use of a Pit Trolley no other form of Transport is permitted.

10. RACE CIRCUIT WALK:

- a. All Teams are permitted to undertake their Race Circuit walk on Thursday 30th October between 17:30 – 19:00hrs.
b. GT World Challenge & GT4 Australia Teams Only are permitted to undertake their Race Circuit walk on Thursday 30th October between 08:00 – 09:00hrs.
c. All personnel participating in the Race Circuit walk must wear a **high visibility vest**.

11. TIMING/RACE RADIO:

- a. Timing: Timing for the meeting will be via the MyLaps Transponder system. Transponder hire is \$115 including GST for the meeting. No alternative timing method is available. Please ensure your Transponder is working and fitted correctly. Loss or damage to a hired Transponder will be at the Hirer's expense.
b. Time certain: All events will be "time certain" events. Competitors will be advised if the listed times vary on the day.
c. Race Radio: This will be used for all major announcements for all Classes including Race penalties and is compulsory at NextGen Rounds. The frequency for Race Radio for Bridgestone GR86 Championship, TA2NZ Championship and Summerset GT New Zealand is **489.6811250 Colour Code 10 Digital**, for All other Categories it is **455.168750 MHz Code 6B analogue (179.9)**.
d. Race Management Channel: for GT World Challenge pwd by AWS & Monochrome GT4 Australia Competitors are to use the radio frequency for RMC as supplied by the Series Managers prior to the Event.

12. GENERAL INFORMATION:

- a. Circuit Light Signals:
The Circuit's Approved Signal Light System in conjunction with Flags shall be used for this event.
b. Fuel Handling and Storage:
Competitors are reminded to ensure that they are familiar with and abide by the MotorSport New Zealand Code of Practice – Fuel Handling and Storage. This can be found on the MotorSport New Zealand website – <https://motorsport.org.nz/technical/fuel/> in particular the requirement to have a maximum of 40ltrs stored in your Pit location during the day. NO fuel is to be stored in your Pit location overnight. There is no fuel sales available at the Circuit.
c. Each Competitor must have a minimum of one (1) 4.5 KG multi-purpose dry powder extinguisher in their Pit Marquee at all times and with reference to MotorSport New Zealand Fuel Handling Code of Practice.
d. Promoters decals will be issued to the Series Coordinators to be placed on the Competition Vehicle.

13. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS (Provisional):

- a. Attached is the intended schedule of events. These may be varied or altered at the Promoter's discretion to ensure that all Category Sessions and Races stay on Schedule. You will be notified of any change as soon as possible and the organisers will do everything possible to maintain your involvement as an import part of the program.
b. The Organiser, in consultation with the Stewards of the Event, reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event or any part thereof for reasons of Force Majeure, any entry fee refund will be made only at the discretion of the Organisers.
